

CHANGES TO CMASL SCHEDULED GAMES

Including Games Not Played

Read and understand this Game Cancellation and/or Change Procedure:

1. **Notification of a Game Change is the responsibility of the Manager of the team making the change.**
 1. Games changed **two (2) days or more** before the scheduled game date:
 - The Referee assignor, the two (2) Opposing team managers and League Secretary must be contacted by email - **WITH CONFIRMATION FROM Ref Assignor, One Team Manager & League Secretary.**
 - Game has **NOT** changed until **ALL THREE RESPOND!**
 2. Games changed the **day before** the scheduled date **or on Game Day:**
 - **You must CALL the two opposing team managers and the Referee. Emails are NOT an accepted method.** The League secretary does not need to be called. Email the Secretary of the change.
 - Do not call the ref assignor Paul (Ref Assignor). **You must call the Referee directly and at least one Team Manager.**
 - **Game is NOT changed until you speak to the Referee, and one Team Manager.**
 - If you get voicemail, you must get a return call or voicemail before the game is considered changed.
 3. Who's the referee? What's the phone number?
 1. Log onto the CMASL website and click on the Roster / Forms Page tab found on the left-hand side of the Main Page.
 2. Under "**Game Forms**" click on "**Referee Schedule.**" You will be shown the Referees assigned for the week with their Phone #'s. ([See links below](#))
 3. This schedule will be updated Friday PM weekly. Be sure to refresh your browser to receive the latest version.
 4. If the Game Change Procedures are NOT followed correctly:
 1. The Team making the change will be responsible for any Referee Fee.
 2. This team may be responsible for possible field costs.
 3. The game could possibly be recorded as a forfeit.
2. **IMPORTANT – All games must be completed as originally scheduled. The game is NOT officially "changed" until you receive the proper confirmations from the Referee and one opposing team Manager.**
3. The team Managers phone numbers and emails are on the Website [League/Fields](#) page. The Referee Assignor and League Secretary emails are also on the Website [Home page](#). The actual Game Day Referee's number is also on the Website [Forms page](#) under 'Referee Schedule'.
4. Possible Cancellations or Changes to games:
 1. Game is cancelled and both teams agree to re-schedule or not play the game.
Note: The game will be re-scheduled to the next available Sunday which can be changed by mutual agreement.
 2. One team does not agree to re-schedule – The team that requested the cancellation or change forfeits. **AVOID** this if at all possible, make every effort to play the game.
 3. Remember – Re-scheduling is difficult, especially in the Fall. Make every effort to play the game as scheduled. Only 9 players is not an excuse.

Procedure for games Not played or Re-Scheduled:

When a game is not played for any reason (other than a forfeit) the game is automatically Re-scheduled to the next available Sunday at 9 AM.

These automatically re-scheduled games may be changed to another date. If both Team managers agree the game may be played on **any day at any time**. If teams agree to change the date both Managers, the Referee Assignor and League Secretary **MUST** be notified.

All games on the schedule are required to be played. If one team cannot or refuses to play a scheduled game, that team forfeits.

Games can also be 'Dropped' from the schedule - If BOTH teams agree to NOT play the game, it is not played and the teams stats will show one less game. There is no penalty for this decision.
